2 HOUR SAILING OPTIONS (cruises are available in either direction)

- Sail from Banavie to Laggan, including Loch Lochy, through two locks and two swing bridges. Enjoy views of Ben Nevis and the spectacular waterfalls at Clunes.
- Sail from Laggan to Fort Augustus, including Loch Oich, through four locks, stunning Laggan Avenue and one swing bridge. Enjoy close up views of Glengarry Castle.



Cruise boat

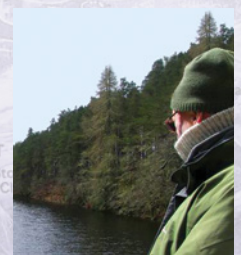
